What is the FARE Patient Registry?

The FARE Patient Registry is a secure database of health information that helps food allergy researchers make new discoveries. The Registry allows people with food allergies and their caregivers to share their food allergy experiences conveniently and privately by taking simple online surveys. The information people share in the Registry helps researchers:

- Better understand food allergy and its impact
- Improve the care food allergy patients receive
- Find new ways to diagnose, treat and, ultimately, cure this life-changing disease

Who can join?

You are eligible to join the Registry if a doctor has diagnosed you or your child with a food allergy. If you are under 18 years of age, you will need a parent or guardian to join.

How will my information be kept private?

The data that Registry participants share is personal. FARE follows strict security protocols and processes to ensure data is always well-protected.
