traveling		Pack safe snacks or meals Bring wipes for surfaces and hands Be sure everyone knows what to do in case of an emergency
Restaurants		Research dining options along your route Call restaurants ahead and ask to speak to a manager or chef about their policies for managing food allergies
Image: constraint of the second sec		 Find accommodations with a microwave and refrigerator so that you can safely warm up and store safe foods Perform a visual inspection of your room upon arrival for loose food or residue Determine where the nearest emergency department is in case a reaction occurs
Hosts		Have a conversation with your hosts in advance to ensure they understand your food allergy safety rules
